## Resolution #63 Appointing Christopher D'Ambro as a Town Councilman

WHEREAS, Councilman Ken Petronis died on October 7, 2017 and his elected term expires on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor has duly called and noticed a Special Town Board Meeting at 6:00 pm on October 12, 2017 at Town Hall pursuant to his authority under NYS Town Law section 62 (2) in order to appoint a successor to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has authority and discretion under the NY Constitution, Article XIII, Section 3 and the NYS Town Law section 64 (5) to appoint Councilman Petronis' successor to serve until the commencement of the calendar year next succeeding the first annual election at which the vacancy may be filled; and

WHEREAS, Christopher J. D'Ambro of Independence Row, Stillwater has been an active leader in many community organizations, is professionally experienced in many capacities in the banking industry and is currently a voting member of the Town of Stillwater Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has duly considered Mr. D'Ambro's many qualifications for continuing to serve the residents of Stillwater as a Town Councilman and has also considered his offer to resign from the Town's Planning Board.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board, with regret, hereby acknowledges the passing of Councilman Ken Petronis yet commemorates and applauds his many years of faithful and exemplary service to the Town since 1973 as a Town Justice and as a Town Councilman since 1987; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby accepts the resignation of Christopher J. D'Ambro from his current position as a Member of the Town's Planning Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town board hereby exercises its discretion and authority under the NY Constitution, Article XIII, Section 3 and NYS Town Law section 64 (5) to appoint

Christopher J. D'Ambro as a Town Councilman to fill the vacancy created by the death of Councilman Ken Petronis, to serve until the commencement of the calendar year next succeeding the first annual election at which the vacancy may be filled; and be it further

RESOLVED, that if it has not been done already, the Town Clerk is directed to immediately notify the Saratoga County Clerk pursuant to the NYS Public Officer's Law sections 37 and 42, and the Saratoga County Board of Elections pursuant to NYS Election Law section 4-106 of the vacancy as well as the appointment and their effective dates.
