WHEREAS, a bid submitted by Cutting Edge Group, LLC for Contract 1 of the Project, base amount and the total amount with all Alternatives were the lowest responsive bids for the general construction of the water transmission and distribution facilities;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby accepts the bids submitted by Cutting Edge Group, LLC in the amount of \$2,248,756.00 for the base bid, and in the total amount of \$2,827,955.00 including all four Alternatives for Contract 1 of the SCWA Connection Project for the general construction of the water transmission and distribution facilities; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board also finds that Cutting Edge Group, LLC is a responsible bidder and that the base bid and each of the Alternate bids Cutting Edge Group, LLC submitted to be responsive to the Town's bid specifications for Contract 1 of the SCWA Water System Connection Project; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Cutting Edge Group, LLC for the stated installation of the water transmission and distribution facilities at the stated price and to disburse the needed funds as appropriate.

RESOLVED that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with CB&I, Inc. for the stated installation of the water transmission and distribution facilities at the stated price and to disburse the needed funds as appropriate.

RESOLVED, that pursuant to, and in accordance with, the provisions of the New York Local Finance Law, the Supervisor of the Town of Stillwater be and hereby is authorized and empowered to issue and sell, in the manner provided by the Local Finance Law, a Bond Anticipation Note or Bond Anticipation Notes in an amount not to exceed \$5,500,000.00, at such rate of interest as the said Supervisor of the Town of Stillwater shall prescribe, for the SCWA Connection Project in anticipation that a Bond may become necessary.
