for Funds Associated With The Community Development Block Grant for Water District No. 6

WHEREAS, the CDBG program is administered by the NYS Office of Community Renewal and the selected project may be eligible for up to \$750,000 in grant funds; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing is required prior to the applying for CDBG funds through the 2019 NYS Consolidated Funding Application (CFA) process.
